### Spotlight on Y3

This week we went to Tatton Park to learn about the Anglo Saxons. We left school early and went on the coach, it took about forty minutes to get there. It is near to Manchester Airport. It was a hard life as they did not have houses like ours. The houses were made of wood and straw and were all on one level, it was just one big room about as big as the office. They had no running water. They lived near to the river and had to keep going to the river. We dressed up to go and I wore trousers, a tie and a hat and I wore a long dress and hat.

We learnt that they had deers, but you don't kill the deers that don't have horns as they may be expecting babies or be very young. They also had chickens and pigs. The pigs on the farm were really fat and they would kill them for their meat and fat.

We were all given shields and the man had a bow and arrow and a sword. He told us that if you knew an arrow was coming towards you you had to put the shield over your head as the arrow would arch up and then come down. If someone had a sword you would have the shield in front of you. It was heavy.

#### Widnes Royal British Legion

Our school has recently linked with the Royal British Legion who will be coming into school on a regular basis to work with us. We will be representing our school on Sunday July 3<sup>rd</sup> to commemorate 100 years since the Battle of the Somme. Further details will follow shortly.

There will also be a parade by British Legion, Standards and Widnes Army Cadets and bands on Saturday 28<sup>th</sup> May at 10.30am in Widnes Cemetery. Wreaths will be laid on Commonwealth war grave headstones by cadets and families. 36 firework rockets will be set off to simulate the guns.
