We were able to talk about and respond to questions about what it means to be sorry and forgive others when they have done something wrong. 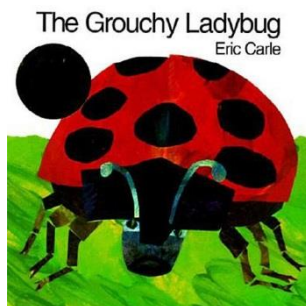

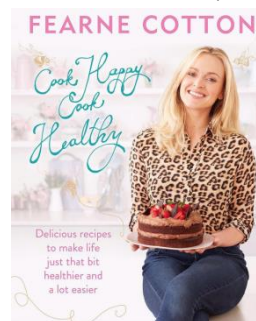
