Dear Parents / Carers,



English

We have enjoyed watching *The Gruffalo's Child* film that was on television a couple of years ago. It is the same story as the book which we have enjoyed many times but we loved the animation and talked about the bits that were added in to flesh out the text from the book. The children learnt about instructional language and time connectives this week and for our Big Write we wrote an information text called 'How to Catch a Gruffalo'. Miss Cook and I really enjoyed reading this piece of work! There were some brilliant ideas including dressing up as a lady Gruffalo and pretending to go in for a kiss but instead capturing *The Gruffalo* with a net! Oh how we smiled at the imaginative ideas! Never a dull moment when reading the children's brilliant work.

Maths

This week we have been working on our understanding of double and halving. We have taught these concepts together as they are so interlinked and have been recording our work in our new Maths books with squares in. We have had a 'hook' each day to develop the children's problem solving skills and this week it was the turn of *The Gruffalo's Child* to pose questions such as:



Each day of the week the Gruffalo's Child's tree doubles in height. This is the height yesterday which was Monday.

What height is it today? What height will it be tomorrow?

Letters and Sounds

Please can we ask that you practice the Phase 5 sounds and alien words with your child at home. This is in preparation for our Phonics Screening Check after half term. The children have been told about this but we have called it 'Show Off Week' where they will show off their fantastic understanding of Phase 3 and 5 sounds with Mrs Mitchell. The words they will be reading will be in a 'Show Off Booklet' so if you choose to talk to your child about the screening please do talk about in this way. We don't want the children to feel any pressure

that week and as far as they know it will be a normal week for them. Thank you for your support. ☺


