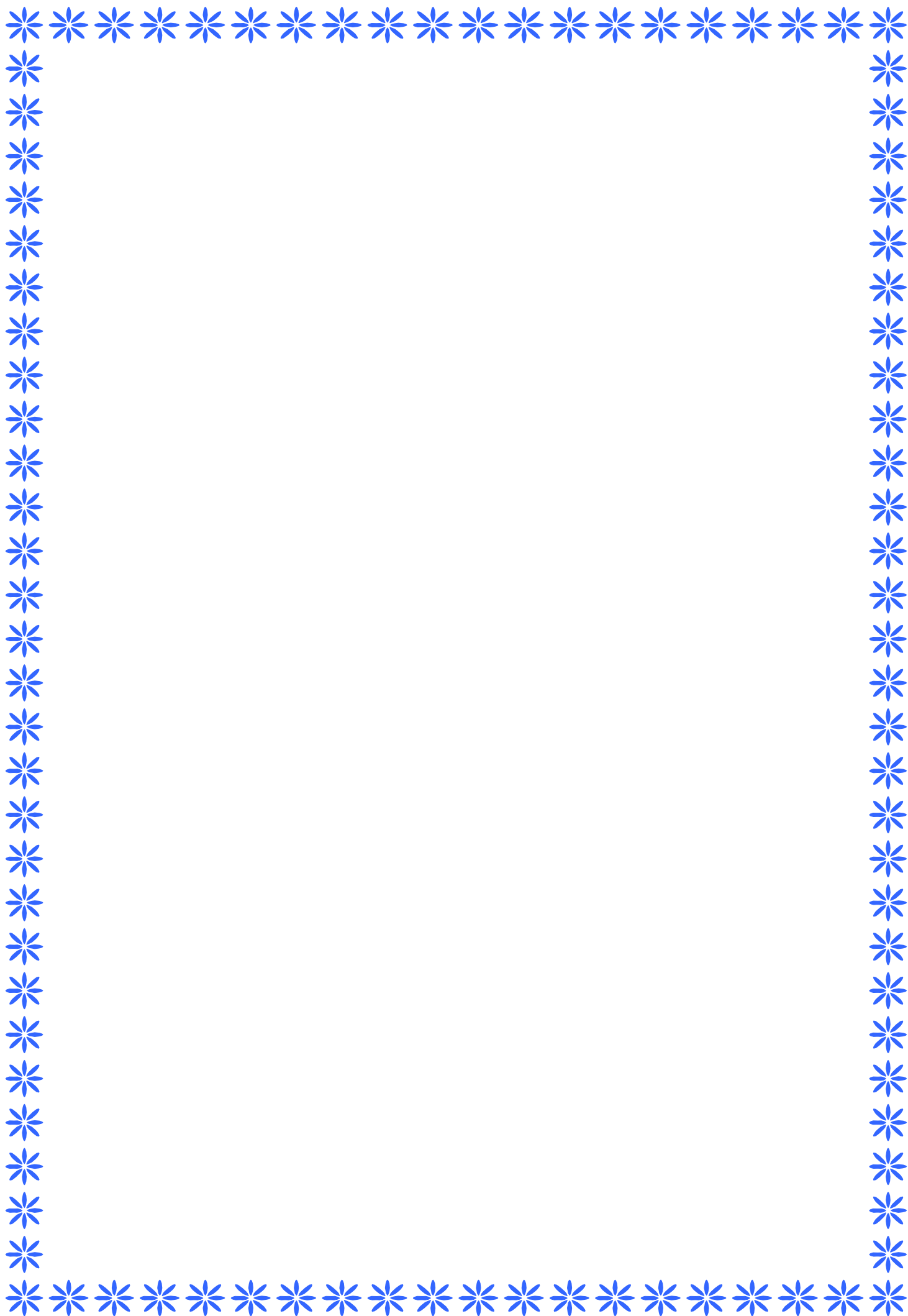

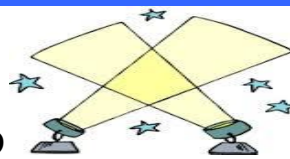
Junior Chefs
