Dear Parents/Carers,

An educational visit has been arranged for the Year 6 children to visit the Jewish Museum as part of their 'Come and See' work.

The children will learn about Jewish Faith through engaging, interactive and sensory activities created to encourage exploration and discovery. By the end of the session pupils will be able to answer the following questions:

What happens in a synagogue?
What can you do on the Jewish Sabbath?
What is the story of the festival of Passover?

By the end of the session pupils will have developed the following skills:

- Explain and communicate concepts, rituals and practices.
- See the world through the eyes of others and appreciate issues from their point of view.
- Apply what has been learnt from a religion to a new situation.
- Interpret and draw meaning from stories.

The children will complete the workshop at the Jewish Museum in the morning and then head to the Imperial War Museum for the afternoon session. The children will visit the IWM to find out about WWI and complete a WWI trail.

The educational visit will take place on Wednesday  $9^{th}$  November and we will leave school at approximately 8.45am and return at 3.15pm

The cost of the trip will be £13.00 which includes the cost of the coach and the cost of the workshop that the children will complete at the Jewish Museum.

The children will need to wear their school uniform and bring a packed lunch in a disposable bag please.
