Childcare Vouchers

We've had a few enquiries recently about childcare vouchers. School can only accept vouchers for Nursery wrap around hours, Breakfast and After School Club (Clubhouse) and Extra -Curricular clubs. Unfortunately, they can't be used for payment for school trips, swimming lessons or residentials. If you have any questions about this please contact the office.

Dogs on school premises

Dogs are an important part of life for many Holy Family families, and as such, are often included in day-to-day activities such as walking children to and from school. As a school, we appreciate this inclusion and value pet ownership as an educational experience. We also acknowledge other people (both adults and children) can find contact with dogs stressful and frightening.



Currently we allow dogs to be walked onto the yard when dropping off or picking up the children. As the playground will be getting busier with the staggered timings stopping after half term, please can we remind you about safety around dogs and ask that you follow our guidance below and discuss this with your children.

- All dogs must be kept on a short lead and should be held and watched by adults at all times.
- Please stand in a space away from crowded areas, preferably near the perimeter
 of the playground/railings when waiting for children at the end of the day.
- Dogs must not be tied up anywhere on the school premises
- Children should not stroke a dog without the owner's permission.
- Even with permission, children should know how to approach a dog and where the dog likes to be stroked all dogs are different and many dislike having their head touched.
- Some children are very fearful of dogs so please ensure your dog doesn't jump up at anyone.
- Parents are responsible for cleaning up any soiling by their dog on the school grounds
- When bringing dogs on to the site, parents do so with an absolute understanding that their dog has no issues around children, has never displayed any aggression towards children and that the owner believes the dog is fully trustworthy in a school environment.

Thank you for your support with this. You know your dog's temperament the best so if unpredictable, noisy, crowded spaces may cause them distress, please err on the side of caution, and leave your dog at home. We are a school of dog lovers, but the safety and wellbeing of our children is our top priority.

Christmas cards



The company can also accept good quality sleeping bags to help the homeless community. By installing a recycled clothing bin, the PTA will receive £300 per tonne for quality textiles.
