10th December - Christmas Jumper Day and Christmas Dinner


If you would like your child to have Christmas dinner, please book on Parent Pay by Friday 3rd December at the latest.

The cost of the trip is £13, which includes the ticket for the pantomime and a drink and snack for your child during the interval. You will be able to make a payment via Parent Pay for the trip from Monday 29th November.
