<p>Through our Come and See curriculum we will study the following topics:</p> <p>Spread the Word: to understand that the gift of Holy Spirit, which is celebrated at Pentecost, strengthens Christians to share in the mission of the Church by spreading the Good News of the message of love of the risen Christ.</p> <p>Rules: to understand that the Christian Christ's rule of love of God and neighbour offers freedom and happiness.</p> <p>Treasure: Christians believe that life is God's gift. Appreciating that all is gift leads us to treasure everything in life.</p> 	<p>We will study the theme about conservation through the book 'Just So' Stories by Rudyard Kipling. We will focus on the key skills for writing a narrative story (in manner of Kipling) and newspaper reports.</p>  <p>We will also be studying the theme of journeys through the book Lubna and Pebble by Wendy Meddour. We will focus on the key skills to write a setting description, a non-chronological report, narrative story (in manner of Kipling), and a newspaper report.</p> 	<p>We will learn about Measure including- Length and Height, by choosing and using appropriate standard units to estimate and measure length/height in any direction (m/cm). In mass we will learn about measuring in (kg/g). In temperature we will measure to the nearest degree(°C); In capacity we will measure in (litres/ml).</p> <p>In Time we will focus on learning to tell and write the time to five minutes.</p> <p>In Geometry we will use mathematical vocabulary to describe position, direction and movement.</p>
<p>HISTORY</p> <p>We will be closely looking at Inventors. Focusing on the development of communications across periods of time ranging from Caxton to Bell, leading to modern day communication. During this topic we will be learning about what Caxton did that was so important to us today and how he helped to change the way books were made.</p> <p>We will also think about the importance of Bell's invention then and now. Exploring how the telephone has improved since the days of Bell?</p>	<p>GEOGRAPHY</p> <p>We will be looking at Mugurameno village in Zambia. We will Locate Zambia on a map and explore the physical and human features.</p> <p>We will then locate the village of Mugurameno. We will look in more detail at how the river is used in the village, looking at the villagers' houses and comparing our life with that of the villagers</p> 	<p>SCIENCE</p> <p>We will learn about the differences between things that are living, dead, and things that have never been alive. We will explore different habitats and micro-habitats and how the different habitats provide the basic needs of different kinds of animals and plants, and how they depend on each other. We will then look at how animals obtain their food from plants and other animals, using the idea of a simple food chain, and identify and name different sources of food.</p> 
<p>ART</p> <p>We will be using clay to create Asian elephants focusing on the key skills of moulding and shaping and manipulating malleable materials in a variety of ways using a range of tools.</p> 	<p>DESIGN & TECHNOLOGY</p> <p>Through their exploration of what makes a balanced diet, the children will taste test food combinations of different food groups. We will also aim to make a wrap that includes a healthy mix of protein, vegetables and dairy, and learn about the term 'hidden'.</p> 	<p>COMPUTING</p> <p>In Computing we will be looking at using a search engine to create our own version of charades game.</p>  <p>We will then create our own version of a scavenger hunt game by creating QR codes and maths videos.</p>
