Key Vocabulary:

Compose - creating or writing a piece of music **Dynamics** – refers to the volume or loudness of the sound or note Melody - a series of different pitches that form a tune **Pitch** - describes how low or high a note sound Pulse - a steady beat Rhythm - Pattern in time Rhythmic pattern - a repetitive pattern of strong and weak beats Structure - the arrangement and order of the parts or sections of the music Tempo - describe the speed at which you play **Texture** - different layers of a piece of music are combined to produce the overall sound
