Year 5: PSHE spring term

<u>Themes:</u> Protecting the environment; compassion towards others, how information online is targeted; different media types, their role and impact, Identifying job interests and aspirations; what influences career choices; workplace stereotypes.

Throughout the term, children will learn:

About how resources are allocated and the effect this has on individuals, communities and the environment.

The importance of protecting the environment and how everyday actions can either support or damage it.

How to show compassion for the environment, animals and other living things.

To identify different types of media and their different purposes e.g. to entertain, inform, persuade or advertise.

Basic strategies to assess whether content online (e.g. research, news, reviews, blogs) is based on fact, opinion, or is biased.

To recognise unsafe or suspicious content online.

To identify jobs that they might like to do in the future.

About the role ambition can play in achieving a future career.

About what might influence people's decisions about a job or career, including pay, working conditions, personal interests, strengths and qualities, family, values.

Key vocabulary:

Communities: a group of people living in the same place or having a particular characteristic in common.

Environment: the surroundings or conditions in which a person, animal, or plant lives or operates.

Compassion: sympathetic pity and concern for the sufferings or misfortunes of others.

Media: the main means of mass communication (broadcasting, publishing, and the internet) regarded collectively.

Persuade: induce (someone) to do something through reasoning or argument.

Biased: unfairly prejudiced for or against someone or something.

Suspicious: having or showing a cautious distrust of someone or something.

Job: a paid position of regular employment.

Ambition: a strong desire to do or achieve something.

Influence: the capacity to have an effect on the character, development, or behaviour of

someone or something, or the effect itself.
