Enquiry Process



Decide on a topic of interest.

Determine what you already know.

Decide what you want to find out and finalise your enquiry question.

Determine who you will need to talk to and what data you need to collect.

Choose the most effective data collection methods.

Design and test your data collection Decide on a route in your chosen location and plot data collection points on a map.

Carry out your fieldwork.

Analyse your data.

Think about suggestions or improvements to the local issue.

Vocabulary

Analyse—To look at something in detail to help explain it.

Audience—The people who receive a message or watch a performance.

City -A large settlement with millions of people.

Data -Numbers or facts collected to prove something.

Data collection methods - A particular way to collect specific data.

Enquiry -An investigation into a question.

Evidence -Information or items to prove something is true.

Justify -To explain a decision made.

Impact -The influence one thing has on another.

Improvement -To make something better than it was.

Plot -To mark a point on a map.

Presenting -To show something to other people.

Process -Steps taken to achieve a particular outcome.

Recommendation-Suggesting advice in a specific situation.

Region -The largest scale area that a country is divided into.

Risk -A situation where something may be dangerous.

Route -A way to get from one place to another, marked on a map.

Subjective -Influenced by personal opinions.

Viewpoint -A particular way of thinking about something...
