

Vocabulary

Capital City: From where the government of a country functions.

 $\textbf{Scorched:} \ \textbf{Burned surface, changes in its colour and texture.} \ \ \textbf{Dry or shrivel}$

with intense heat.

Great: Considerably above average. **Fire:** Bright light, heat, and smoke.

Burning: Very hot, flaming and on fire.

Evidence: Facts or information

Curator: A keeper or custodian of a museum.

Diary: A book in which one keeps a daily record of events and experiences.
