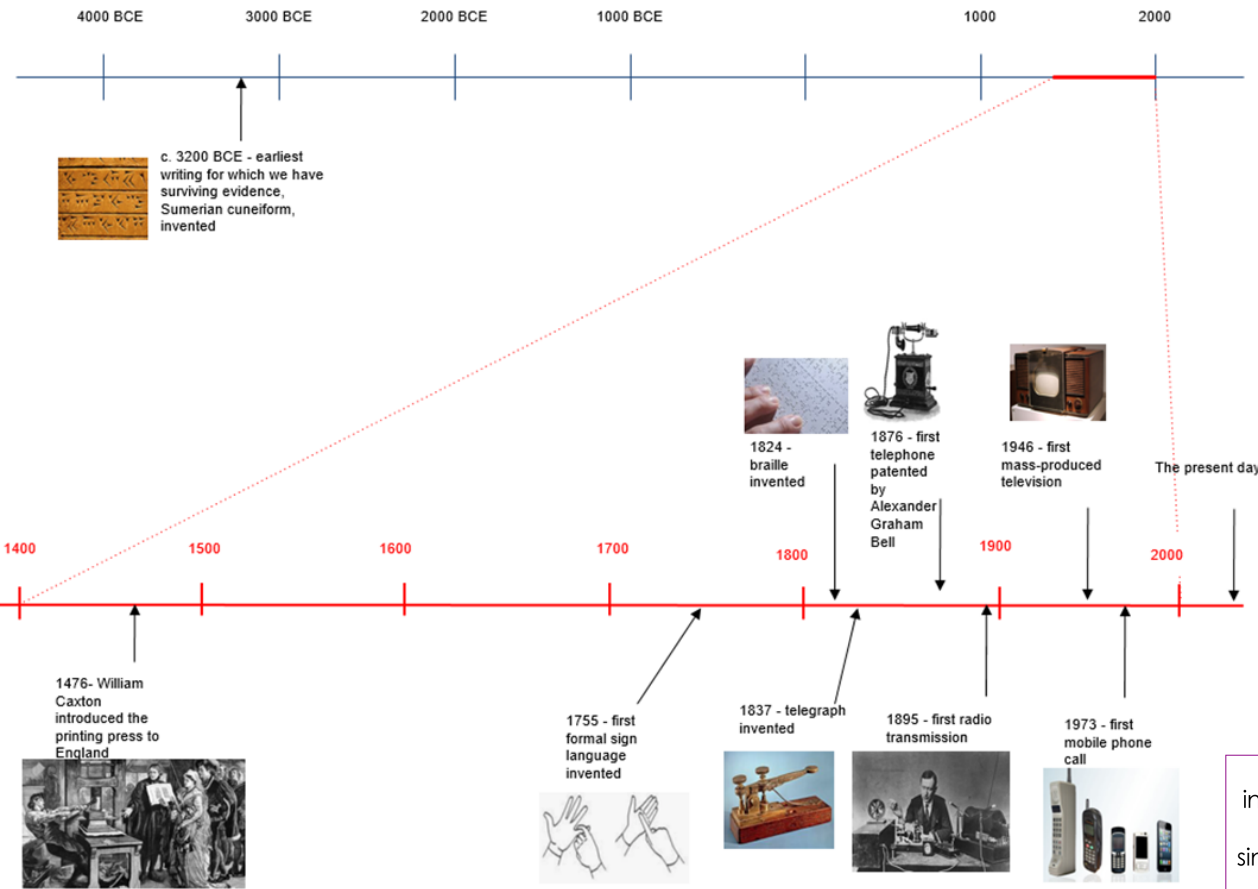


Y2 - Spreading the Word: From Caxton to Bell

Vocabulary
