
# Year 2: Unit 1 Hands, Feet, Heart

**Themes: South African music** 

**1 - Listening:** Hands, Feet, Heart Find the pulse as you are listening to the music: Can you dance, get funky or find the groove? Instruments/voices you can hear: keyboard, bass, drums, electric guitars, saxophone, trumpet, vocals.

### 2 - Musical Activities Find the pulse!

- What animal can you be finding the pulse? Clapping Rhythms
- Copy and clap back rhythms
- Clap the rhythm of your name
- Make up your own rhythm Singing
- Sing Hands, Feet, Heart in groups
- Have fun! Playing instruments using up to three notes – G or G, A + C.
  Which part did you play?



#### Improvise using the notes C + D:

- Challenge 1 Clap and Improvise
- Challenge 2 Sing, Play and Improvise
- Challenge 3 Improvise

Which challenge did you get to? Compose a simple melody using simple rhythms, choosing from the notes C + D or C, D + E. Which notes did you use?



**3 - Perform & Share** A class performance of Hands, Feet, Heart. Introduce your performance to your audience. Can you include some funky moves? Have a fantastic time; enjoy it! Talk about it together afterwards. How did it make you feel? Will you record it?

#### **Key Vocabulary:**

Pulse - a steady beat

**Rhythm** - Pattern in time

Pitch - describes how low or high a note sound

**Compose -** creating or writing a piece of music

**Improvise** - playing an instrument or singing in which the musician makes up the music as they play.

**Melody** - a series of different pitches that form a tune **Dynamics** –

Tempo -

**Perform** - music and ideas shared with a listener or audience

**Audience** – people who are listeners

**Keyboard** - a portable electronic musical instrument with a row of keys like that of a piano

Bass - a tone of low pitch

**Drums** - a drum is a type of musical instrument . In most cases it consists of a shell with a stretched skin or covering. When the covering is hit with a hand or a stick, it vibrates and makes a sound

**Electric Guitar** - stringed instrument that makes music using "electric pickups" that change the vibration of the strings into electric current. sent to an amplifier that changes it to sound

**Trumpet** - a brass musical instrument that consists of a tube formed into a long loop with a wide opening at one end and that has valves by which different tones are produced

**Saxophone** - a woodwind instrument usually in the form of a curved metal tube with keys used to change pitch and a mouthpiece with a single reed
