# Year 1: Unit 4 Round and round

## <u>Themes:</u> Pulse, rhythm and pitch in different styles of music.



1 - Listening: Round and Round Find the pulse as you are listening to the music: Can you dance, get funky of find the groove? Instruments/voices you can hear: Singers, keyboard, bass, guitar, percussion, trumpets and saxophones. Can you recognise any of these instruments in the other songs?

- Copy and clap back rhythms
- Clap the rhythm of your name
- Clap the rhythm of your favourite animal
- Make up your own rhythms Pitch is high and low sounds.

#### **Key Vocabulary:**

Audience - people who are listeners

Bass - a tone of low pitch

**Compose -** creating or writing a piece of music

**Guitar** - stringed instrument that

makes music from the vibrations of strings

**Improvise** - playing an instrument or singing in which the musician makes up the music as they play.

**Keyboard** - a portable electronic musical instrument with a row of keys like that of a piano **Melody** - a series of different pitches that form a tune

**Percussion instruments** – those which are struck, shaken, scraped, plucked or rubbed to create a sound

**Perform** - music and ideas shared with a listener or audience

**Pitch** - describes how low or high a note sounds

Pulse - a steady beat

**Rhythm** - Pattern in time

**Saxophone** - a woodwind instrument usually in the form of a curved metal tube with keys used to change pitch and a mouthpiece with a single reed

**Trumpet** - a brass musical instrument that consists of a tube formed into a long loop with a wide opening at one end and that has valves by which different tones are produced
