	Audience – people who are listeners Bass - a tone of low pitch Compose - creating or writing a piece of music Drums - a drum is a type of musical instrument In most cases it consists of a shell with a stretched skin or covering. When the covering is hit with a hand or a stick, it vibrates and makes a sound Improvise - playing an instrument or singing in which the musician makes up the music as they play. Keyboard - a portable electronic musical instrument with a row of keys like that of a piano Melody - a series of different pitches that form a tune Perform - music and ideas shared with a listener or audience Pitch - describes how low or high a note sound Pulse - a steady beat Rhythm - Pattern in time
