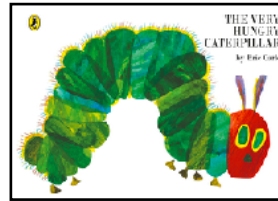
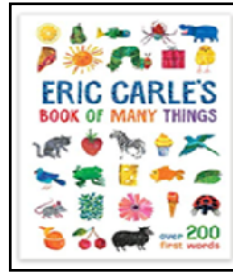


Artists

Eric Carle (1929-2021) was an American-German writer and illustrator of children's books. He has illustrated more than 70 books.

The themes of his stories are usually nature and the walks his father would take him on across meadows and through woods as a child.

He is best known for his stories 'The Very Hungry Caterpillar' and 'Brown Bear, Brown Bear, What Do You See?'
