

Times tables at Holy Family



In the table below, are the National Curriculum times tables expectations for each year group.

Expectations for times tables for each year group:	
Year 1	Count in multiples of 2, 5 and 10. Recall and use all doubles to 10 and corresponding halves.
Year 2	Recall and use multiplication and division facts for the 2, 5 and 10 multiplication tables, including recognising odd and even numbers.
Year 3	Recall and use multiplication and division facts for the 3, 4 and 8 multiplication tables.
Year 4	Recall and use multiplication and division facts for multiplication tables up to 12x12.
Year 5	Revision of all times tables and division facts up to 12x12.
Year 6	Revision of all times tables and division facts up to 12x12.

By the end of Year 4, children should have memorised their times tables up to and including the 12 multiplication table and show precision and fluency in their work.

All Year 4 children will have their multiplication skills formally tested in the summer term. They will have 6 seconds to answer each question. To practise taking times tables tests you can visit this website.
