Henri Matisse was born in 1869 in France. He is known for his bold use of colour and original style.




In 1941, as his health began to deteriorate he developed a technique called “drawing with scissors.” With the help of his assistants Matisse would paint large pieces of paper that he would cut out and arrange on his studio wall with a stick.
