Quentin Blake is an English cartoonist, caricaturist, illustrator and children's writer. He has illustrated over 300 books, including 18 written by Roald Dahl, which are among his most popular works. Quentin uses his drawing to purposely exaggerate certain characteristics of the body to convey a sense of action or intention. For example, Mrs Armitage expresses her need for a sink by showing us her super-long, super-straight, mud-splattered arms.
