


Artists

Frances Hatch is a plein-air artist who responds creatively to the landscape around her. Francis uses the natural materials available to her in the environment that she is painting in, for example soil and grass or rock pigment.

Anna Atkins was a botanist and photographer in the 1800s. She is considered as the first person to publish a book of photographs. She used cyanotypes to create blueprints of botanical specimens.
