Hannah Hoch (1889 - 1978) was a German Dada artist known for pioneering the technique of photomontage. Dadaism is an artistic movement in Modern Art that started around World War I. Its purpose was to ridicule the modern world and go against normal social norms. Hoch's work focuses on gender roles in society and the idea of the modern woman.

Key Vocabulary

Photomontage	The process of cutting, glueing, layering and rearranging two or more photographs together to make an image.
Cubism	A art style developed in the early 20th century, where the artwork looks like it has been cut up into pieces and reassembled.
Hatching	A mark making technique used to create tone or shading.

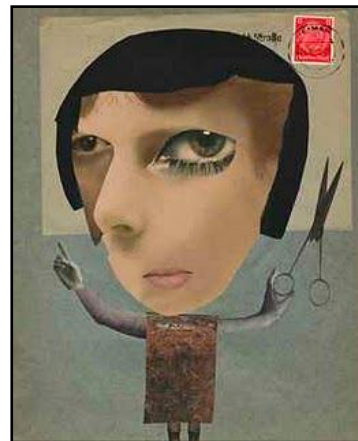
