Keith Haring (1958-1990) was an American artist who is known for colourful, cartoon artworks and certain characters such as crawling babies, barking dogs and spaceships. He was inspired by graffiti artists and often drew in chalk on New York subways. Many of his figures often look like they are dancing, inspired perhaps by Keith's own love of hip-hop music. Keith wanted everyone to experience his artwork and to make artwork for themselves.

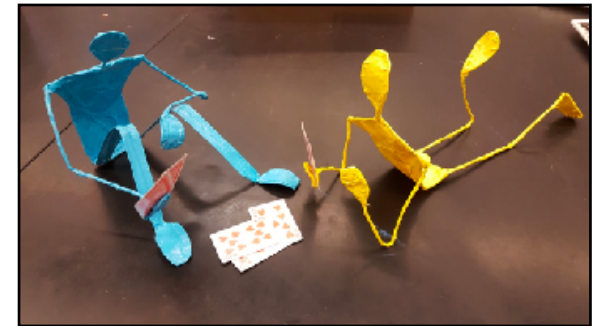
