Chauvet Cave was discovered in 1994 in South East France. It is thought to be one of the most important prehistoric art sites in the world. Inside, there are some of the best preserved cave paintings ever found.

The first drawing tools humans used were charcoal and earth pigments. The cave paintings were a way of communicating and often showed animals, people, symbols and handprints.
