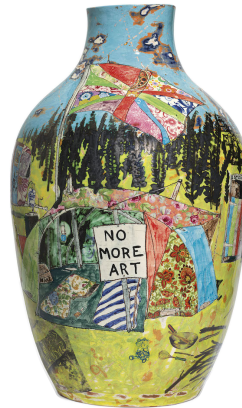


Artists

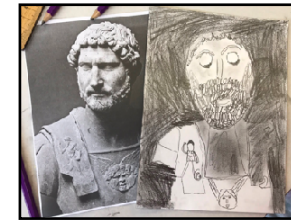

Key Vocabulary

Pencil Types	Pencils come in different types, called grades. Hard pencils (H), soft pencils (B) and a HB pencil is in the middle.
Coils	A piece of clay that is rolled into a slender snake-like shape that is joined together at the ends to make a circle.
Slip	Watered down clay that is used as a 'glue' to join pieces of clay together.
Craftsperson	A worker skilled in a particular craft, like pottery.
