


Welcome!



Pupil Premium

Could you be eligible to receive extra support during school holidays?

Your child may be eligible to receive support for meals during the school holidays and support towards resources in school with Pupil Premium funding, if you are in receipt of any of the following:

- Universal Credit, provided you have an annual net earned income not exceeding £7,400 (wages below £616.67 a month)
- Income Support
- Income-based Jobseekers Allowance
- An income-related Employment and Support Allowance
- Child Tax Credit with an annual income of £16,190 or less (but not if you are in work and receive Working Tax Credit)
- The guarantee element of State Pension Credit
- Support under part VI of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999

To apply visit your local authority's website and use the Parent Portal to see if you are eligible.

Payment Requirements

Termly Snack Fund:

In our Early Years setting, we request a termly donation of £1 per week to support the purchase of resources within our Continuous Provision.

This donation helps to support special events in school such as seasonal parties, special treats such as ice lollies in the warm weather and (most importantly) a healthy daily snack.

This fund will be available to pay via your Arbor app.

- Black shoes






In summer months,

When your child starts Reception, you will receive an activation email for an Arbor Parent/Guardian account via the email address you have provided to school.

Please download the Arbor app onto your mobile device as this is where you will receive all communications from school and be able to make any payments required.
